

Worship God

The Lord has exalted His Name and His Word above all things. He delights to hear His own Word spoken back to Him in prayer. Use the verses included as a prompt for your own prayers. The prayers interspersed in *blue italics* are merely examples.

Don't just **read** the verses, but **personalize** them, turn **them into worship** back to the Lord. For example, see the first verse on the Lord's Day.

We worship God for **Who HE IS**, we praise Him for **what He has done**. We thank Him for **what He has blessed us with**.

Worship is the heart poured out in wonder and awe, expressing our understanding of **Who He is**. WDW

Worship is not prayer for one's needs, nor praise for one's blessing, but rather the overflow of the heart in adoration to the Father for what He is in Himself, as revealed by the Lord Jesus Christ.

Prayer is the occupation of the heart with its needs; praise, the occupation of the heart with its blessings; but worship is the **occupation of the heart with the Lord Himself**. JBN

Lord's Day

1 Chron 16:29 Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His Name. Bring an offering (an offering of worship, praise, thanksgiving, self, possessions, time, adoration) and come before Him; worship the Lord in the splendor of His holiness.

*Lord, I ascribe to You the glory due Your **Name**. I bring my offering of worship, adoration, praise, thanksgiving, my very self, my possessions, and my time to You. I come before You and worship You in the very splendor of Your holiness. (Personalized)*

Psa 8:1 *O Lord, ~~our~~ my Lord, how majestic is Your **Name** in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.*

God's glory is the sum total of all His attributes and excellencies.

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Prov 18:10 The **Name** of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous runneth to It and are safe. *Your Name, O Lord is a strong tower: I run to Your Name and am forever safe in Christ.*

Safety is not the absence of danger, but the presence of God. "I will never leave thee nor forsake thee." Eternally safe and secure.

Psa 138:2 *I will bow down toward Your holy ~~temple~~ Person and will praise Your **Name** for Your love and Your faithfulness, for You have exalted above all things Your **Name** and Your Word.*

Psa 34:3 Glorify the Lord with me, let us exalt His **Name** together. *Lord, I glorify You and I exalt the **Name** that You have exalted to the highest place.*

Ex 34:6 And He passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness. Lord, You are compassionate and gracious, You are slow to anger and You abound in love and faithfulness.

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Psa 33:6 By the word of the LORD were the heavens made, their starry host by the breath of His mouth. 9 For He spoke, and it came to be; He commanded, and it stood firm. *By Your word O Lord, the heavens were made. All the starry host came into existence by the breath of Your mouth. You spoke and everything came to be; You commanded and it stood firm.*

Heb 12:28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so **worship** God acceptably with reverence and awe, 29 for our God is a consuming fire. *Lord, I desire to worship acceptably, in a way that is well-pleasing to You. I acknowledge that You are a consuming fire and I worship You in reverence and awe.*

Eph 5:10 And **find out what pleases the Lord**. (Worship, praise and adoration certainly do!) *Lord, may Your Spirit enable me to worship and praise You as I ought and as You deserve.*

Psa 69:30 I will praise God's Name in song and glorify Him with thanksgiving. 31 **This will please God** more than an ox, more than a bull with its horns and hoofs. *Father, I praise Your Name in song, and I glorify You with thanksgiving, for I know that this **pleases** You more than sacrifice, more than a bull with its horns and hoofs.*

John 4:23 But the hour is coming and now is, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in Spirit and in truth: for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. 24 God is Spirit, and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth. *Father, I thank You that you seek worshippers, not just any worshipper, but those who worship in spirit and in truth. Lord, that is my desire. May you enable me to worship You in the way that You desire; in spirit and in truth.*

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Wednesday

1 Chron 29:11 *Yours, O Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is Yours. Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom; You are exalted as Head over all. 12. Wealth and honor come from You; You are the ruler of all things. In Your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all. 13. Now, ~~our~~ my God, ~~we~~ I give You thanks, and I praise Your glorious Name.*

Rom 11:33 *O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are ~~His~~ Your judgments and ~~His~~ Your ways past finding out.*

Job 36:26 *How great is God — beyond our understanding! The number of **His years is past finding out.** Father, *You are very great! So great, that it is far beyond human understanding. The number of Your years is beyond finding out, You are from everlasting to everlasting.**

Deut 3:24 *O Sovereign Lord, You have begun to show to Your servant Your greatness and Your strong hand. For what god is there in heaven or on earth who can do the deeds and mighty works You do?*

Psa 99:4 The King is mighty, He loves justice — You have established equity; 5 Exalt the Lord our God and worship at His footstool; He is holy. *Lord, You are mighty, in fact You are Almighty! You love justice. You have established equity. I will exalt You and worship at Your footstool. You are absolutely and intrinsically HOLY.*

Psa 40:5 Many, O Lord my God, are the wonders You have done. The things You planned for us no one can recount to You; were I to speak and tell of them, they would be too many to declare. *Lord, I acknowledge that You are wonderful and all Your works are wonderful. The wonders that You have performed are too many to declare, they are beyond my ability to recount to You.*

Friday

Deut 4:39 Acknowledge and take to heart this day that the Lord is God in heaven above and on the earth below. There is no other.

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Lord, I acknowledge and I take it to heart, that You are Lord. You are God in heaven above and You are God on earth below. You are the One and only God. There is no other God, there is none besides You.
