1 Cor 15:57 *But thanks be unto God, Which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.*

Deut 20:4 *For the LORD your God is the One who goes with you to fight for you against your enemies to give you victory.*

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Jehovah M’Kaddesh: *Lord, You are The Lord Who **makes men holy***

Lev 20:7 Consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I Am the LORD your God. 8 Keep My decrees and follow them. **I Am the LORD, Who makes you holy (Jehovah M’Kaddesh).**

Joshua went up to Him and asked, "Are you for us or for our enemies?" 14 "Neither," He replied, "but **as Commander of the army of the LORD (Jehovah Sabaoth)** I have now come." *Lord, I acknowledge that You are **Jehovah Sabaoth**, You are the Commander of the army of God, and You have come. Not only to the earth to live in a human body, but since the day of Pentecost*

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You have come to abide in every believer by Your Spirit. Now the Commander of the army of God abides within.

2 Ki 6:15 When the servant of the man of God got up and went out early the next morning, an army with horses and chariots had surrounded the city. "Oh, my lord, what shall we do?" the servant asked. 16 "Don't be afraid," the prophet answered. **"Those who are with us are more than those who are with them."** 17 And Elisha prayed, "O LORD, open his eyes so he may see." Then the LORD opened the servant's eyes, and **he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.** *Lord, I know that the One who is in me, is infinitely more than those who are with the army of horses and chariots against me. "If God be for us, who against us"? If the Commander be for us, who against us?*

Jehovah Shalom: *Lord, You are the Lord of peace*

Jud 6:22 When Gideon realized that it was the Angel of the LORD, he exclaimed, "Ah, Sovereign LORD! I have seen the Angel of the LORD face to face!" 23 But the LORD said to him, "Peace! Do not be afraid. You are not going to die." 24 So Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and called it **The LORD is Peace (Jehovah Shalom)**. To this day it stands in Ophrah of the Abiezrites. *Lord, I acknowledge that You are the Lord of peace. There is no peace apart from You.*

Jehovah Tsidkenu: *Lord, You are **the Lord my Righteousness***

Jer 23:5 "The days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will raise up to David a **righteous Branch**, a **King** who will reign wisely and do what is just and right in the land. 6 In His days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety. This is the **Name** by which He will be called: **The LORD Our Righteousness (Jehovah Tsidkenu)**.

Isa 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags. *Lord, I acknowledge that all my righteousness is as filthy rags. If I am to be righteous in Your sight, then You and You alone must make me righteous.*

1 Cor 1:30 It is because of Him that you are in Christ Jesus, Who has become for us wisdom from God — that is, **our righteousness**, holiness and redemption. *Lord, I acknowledge that You are my only righteousness, my holiness and my redemption.*

Jehovah Shamma: *Lord, You are **The Lord Who is there.***
(Omnipresent: here, there, and everywhere!)

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Ezek 48:35 "The distance all around (the city) will be 18,000 cubits. "And the **Name** of the city from that time on will be: **The LORD is There (Jehovah Shamma).**"

Psa 139:8 If I go up to the heavens, you are **there**; if I make my bed in the depths, you are **there**. *Lord, I worship Thee and I acknowledge that You are here, You are there, You are everywhere, You are **Omnipresent**.*

Heb 13:5 Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "**Never will I leave you**; never will I forsake you."

Jehovah Raah: *Lord, You are **The Lord my Shepherd***

Psalm 23:1 **The LORD is my Shepherd (Jehovah Raah)**, I shall not want (I shall lack nothing).

Isaiah 40:11 He tends His flock like a **shepherd**: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to His heart; He gently leads those that have young. *Lord, You tend Your flock like a **shepherd**: You gather the lambs in Your arms and You carry them close to Your heart; You gently lead those that have young.*
