The Lord has exalted His Name and His Word above all things. He delights to hear His own Word spoken back to Him in prayer. Use the verses included as a prompt for your own prayers. The prayers interspersed in *blue italics* are merely examples.

Daily

Eph 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the Ecclesia (the Church) and gave Himself up for her. Lord, I can't love her as You love Your bride (the Church of Christ), but I know that You can. As You live Your life in and through me today, I ask You to love my wife through me.

2 Thes 3:2 And pray that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men, for not everyone has faith. 3 But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one. Lord, I pray that You would deliver her from wicked and evil men, and that You would strengthen and protect her from the evil one all the days of her life.

Psa 4:8 I will lie down and **sleep in peace**, for You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.

Prov 3:24 When you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your **sleep will be sweet**. *Lord, I know that You alone make her dwell in safety. I ask that You would enable her to have no fears, and that when she lies down her sleep would be sweet.*

Prov 3:25 Have no fear of sudden disaster or of the ruin that overtakes the wicked, 26 for the LORD will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being snared. Lord, I pray that You alone would be her confidence, and that she would have no fear of sudden disaster and that You would keep her foot from being snared.

Psa 121:7 The LORD will keep you from all harm — He will watch over your life; 8 the LORD will keep watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore. Lord, I ask You to keep her from

all harm – that You would watch over her life, and her coming and her going, both today and forevermore.

Lord's Day

Rom 6:10 The death He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life He lives, He lives to God. 11 In the same way, reckon yourselves dead indeed unto sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Lord, I pray that You would prompt her to daily reckon herself dead to sin and alive to You, and may You make it real in her experience today and every day.

Eph 1:17 (Personalized) Father, I ask You, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, that You may give her the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that she may know You better. 18 I pray also that the eyes of her heart may be enlightened in order that she may know the hope to which You have called her, the riches of Your glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and Your incomparably great power for her and those who believe. That power is like the working of Your mighty strength, 20 which You exerted in Christ when You raised Him from the dead and seated Him at Your right hand in the heavenly realms, 21 far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every title that can be given, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

Psa 118:24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Lord, today is Your Day, it is the Lord's Day. It is a very special day. May You enable her to rejoice in this day and the privilege of meeting together with fellow believers and enjoying sweet fellowship together.

Php 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus. Lord, I pray that the mind of Christ would be in her continually, that every thought, every decision would be ordered by the indwelling mind of Christ.

Monday

3 Jn 1:2 Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. Lord, I pray that You would enable her to enjoy good health and that You would cause all things to go well for her, even as her soul is getting along well.

Eph 3:14 (Personalized) Lord, for this reason I kneel before You, 15 from whom Your whole family in Heaven and on earth derives its name. 16 I pray That You would grant her, according to the riches of Your glory, to be strengthened with might by Your Spirit in her inner being; 17 That You may experientially dwell in her heart by faith; that she, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge — that she may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Heb 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the Heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest whom we confess. May You cause her to fix her thoughts on Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest today and every day.

Prov 12:4 A wife of noble character is her husband's crown, but a disgraceful wife is like decay in his bones.

Prov 31:10 A wife of noble character who can find? She is worth far more than rubies. Father, I thank You so much for giving me a wife of noble character. You have blessed me so much through her. She is of far greater worth than all this world's riches. Thank You Lord so much for her.

Tuesday

Jn 17:13 I Am coming to You now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of My joy within them. Father, I pray that You would grant her the full measure of Christ's joy within her.

Prov 15:13 A happy heart makes the face cheerful, but heartache crushes the spirit. Lord, may You enable her outward appearance and speech to reflect her inner joy.

Lord, may You enable this to be her song through her days:

Happy am I! All of my sins forgiven, What a great day, life is now worth the livin': One of these days — I'll be enjoying heaven: Now that I know, upward I'll go, happy am I! Author: J. M. Henson Sr.

There's a new song in my heart, since the Savior set me free.

There's a new song in my heart, 'tis a heav'nly harmony.

All my sins are taken away, in the blood of Calvary!

O what peace and joy nothing can destroy, There's a new song in my heart!

Phil 1:9 (Personalized) And this is my prayer for her: that her love for You may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, 10 so that she may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, 11 filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

Eph 4:1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. (Personalized) Lord, I pray that You would enable her to live a life worthy of the calling she has received. 2 I pray that she would be completely humble and gentle, patient, bearing with others in love. 3 I pray that she would make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Prov 31:30 Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised. Lord, I am so thankful that You have given me a wife who loves and fears You. She deserves so much praise. May You enable me to give her the praise that she deserves.

Wednesday

Col 1:9 For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of His will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. 10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please Him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, 11 being strengthened with all power according to His glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience with joy, giving thanks to the Father Who Has qualified you to share in the inheritance of saints in the kingdom of light. Lord, I ask You to fill her with the knowledge of Your will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. 10 And I pray that You would enable her to live a life worthy of the Lord and would please You in every way. I pray that You would enable her to bear fruit in every good work and that she would grow in her knowledge of Yourself. 11 I pray that You would strengthen her with all power according to Your alorious might, so that she may have great endurance and patience with joy, giving thanks to You Who have qualified her to share in the inheritance of saints in the kingdom of light. (Col 1:9-11 Personalized)

2 Thess 2:16 May our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, Who loved us and by His grace gave us eternal encouragement and good hope, encourage your hearts and strengthen you in every good deed and word. Lord, I thank You that You have loved her and by Your grace You have given her eternal encouragement and good hope. I pray that You may encourage her heart and strengthen her in every good deed and word, today and every day.

Lord, I can't love her as I ought because I am encumbered with a sinful nature, but You can! May You love her through me as only You can.

Thursday

Jn 17:17 Sanctify them by Thy truth; Thy Word is truth. *Lord, I thank You that You have sanctified her positionally, forever. I pray that You would daily sanctify her conditionally by Your Truth.*

Eph 5:21 Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. 22 Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the Head of the church, His body, of which He is the Savior. 24 Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything. 25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her 26 to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the Word, 27 and to present her to Himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. 28 In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. 29 After all, no one ever hated his own body, but he feeds and cares for it, just as Christ does the church - 30 for we are members of His body. Father, You have instructed me to love my wife just as You loved Your bride, the Ecclesia, and gave Yourself up for her. Lord, I cannot fulfill this instruction, but I know that You can do it through me. So I ask You to love her through me, just as You love Your espoused bride.

Isa 41:10 Fear thou not; for I Am with thee: be not dismayed; for I Am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness. Lord, I pray that she would have no fears, because You are her God. I ask You to strengthen her and uphold her with Your righteous right hand, all day and every day.

Friday

Phile 1:6 I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ. Lord, I ask You to give her open doors to share the gospel, and that You would give her a full understanding of all that is hers in You.

Col 3:1 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. 3 For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. Lord, I thank You that she has been positionally and eternally raised and seated with Christ. I ask that You would enable her to set her heart and mind on things above, not on earthly things, for she has died with Christ and is now hidden with Him. I thank You that when Christ, Who is her life appears, she will also appear with Him in Glory.

2 Pet 3:18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever! Amen. Lord, I ask that You would cause and enable her to grow daily in grace and in her love and knowledge of You, her Lord and Savior.

Isa 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in Thee. Lord, I pray that her mind would be stayed on You, that she would trust You fully, and that You would keep her in perfect peace.

Saturday

Phil 1:6 Being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. Lord, I thank You for the good work which You have begun in her and for the assurance that You will carry on to completion the good work which You have begun. (1 Thes 5:24 The One Who calls you is faithful and He will do it.)

2 Cor 1:21 Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, set His seal of ownership on us, 22 and put His Spirit in our hearts, as a deposit guaranteeing what is to come. I thank You that You are the One Who makes her stand firm in Christ. I thank You that You anointed her, You set Your seal of ownership on her, and You put Your Spirit in her heart as a deposit guaranteeing what is to come.

Gal 5:16 So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the cravings of the sinful nature. Lord, I pray that she would **always** live by Your Spirit, and that she would **never** gratify the cravings of her sinful nature, but would continually reckon herself dead to sin and alive unto You.

1 Pet 3:1 Wives, in the same way be submissive to your husbands so that, if any of them do not believe the word, they may be won over without words by the behavior of their wives, 2 when they see the purity and reverence of your lives. 3 Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as braided hair and the wearing of gold jewelry and fine clothes. 4 Instead, it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight. 5 For this is the way the holy women of the past who put their hope in God used to make themselves beautiful. They were submissive to their own husbands, 6 like Sarah, who obeyed Abraham and called him her master. You are her daughters if you do what is right and do not give way to fear. 7 Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers. Lord, I thank You for my wife, and I pray that You would enable me to always be considerate of her and treat her with dignity and respect.
