

My Children and Grandchildren

The Lord has exalted His Name and His Word above all things. He delights to hear His own Word spoken back to Him in prayer. Use the verses included as a prompt for your own prayers. The prayers interspersed in *blue italics* are merely examples.

Daily

Psa 127:3 Lo, children are an **heritage** of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is His **reward**. *I thank You for the precious children and GC that You have blessed us with:*

3 Jn 1:2 Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. *Lord, I pray that You would grant each of them good health, and that all may go well with them, even as their souls are getting along well.*

2 Pet 3:18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever! Amen. *Lord, I pray that each one would grow in the grace and knowledge and love of their Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.*

Lord's Day

Psa 37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart. *Lord, I pray that You would prompt and enable each one of them to delight themselves in You, and that You would grant them the righteous desires of their hearts.*

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Psa 118:24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. *Lord, I pray that You would grant each one a delightful Lord's day and that it would be the highlight of their week. I ask that each one would enjoy sweet fellowship with You and with Your people. Grant them all safety on the road.*

Ex 34:24 I will drive out nations before you and enlarge your territory, and no one will covet your land when you go up three times each year to appear before the LORD your God. *Father, I ask that no one would covet their homes or property while they "go up" each week to join the believers for the Lord's Day meetings.*

Jude 24 To Him Who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before His glorious presence without fault and with great joy. *Lord, I thank You that You are able to keep each one of them from stumbling and to present them before Your glorious presence without fault and with great joy.*

2 Tim 1:12 For I know Whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep that which I have committed unto Him against that day. *Father, I commit my children and GC to You. And I ask that You would not only save my children and GC from their sins in the future, but in the here and now. I pray that You would keep them from all sin.*

Deut 6:5 Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. *Father, I pray that each one of them would always love You with all their heart and with all their soul and with all their strength.*

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Job 1:10 “Have You not put a hedge around him and his household and everything he has?” *Lord, I thank You that You **have** put a hedge around each of my children and GC. I thank You that that hedge is impenetrable, and without Your express permission, no one, no-thing can breach it. Please keep them resting and abiding in Yourself and keep them from stumbling or straying.*

Monday and Thursday

Jn 17:13 “I am coming to You now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have **the full measure of My joy** within them.” *Father, I pray that You would enable each one to know and experience the **full measure of Christ’s joy** within them, today and every day.*

2 Tim 2:20 In a wealthy home there are dishes made of gold and silver as well as some made of wood and clay. The expensive dishes are used for guests, and the cheap ones are used in the kitchen or to put garbage in. 21 If you stay away from sin you will be like one of these dishes made of purest gold - the very best in the house - so that Christ Himself can use you for His highest purposes. *Father, I ask You to keep my children and GC from all sin, so that You could use each one of them for Your highest purposes.*

Rom 16:19 Everyone has heard about your obedience, so I am full of joy over you; but I want you to be wise about what is good, and innocent about what is evil. *God, I pray that You would cause my children and GC to be obedient to You and Your Word, to be wise about what is good and to be innocent about what is evil, so that You may be full of joy over them.*

1 Thes 4:11 Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your hands, just as we told you, 12 so that your daily life may win the respect of outsiders and that you will not be dependent on anybody. *God, I pray that my children and GC would live a quiet life, mind their own business, and work with their hands, so that their lives would win the respect of outsiders, and that they would not be dependent on anybody, except You only.*

Tuesday and Friday

Prov 19:14 Houses and wealth are inherited from parents, but a prudent wife is from the Lord. *Father, I ask that if it be Your good and acceptable and perfect will, that You would, in Your own perfect time, bring into our children's and GC's lives, the perfect mate and life partner that You would chose for them and raise up especially for them.*

Col 1:10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please Him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, 11 being strengthened with all power according to His glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience with joy. *Father, I pray that each one of them would live a life worthy of Yourself and would please You in every way so that they would bear fruit in every good work, that they would grow in the knowledge of Yourself, that You would strengthen them with all power according to Your glorious strength, and may they have great endurance and patience with joy in their hearts.*

1 Jn 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. 16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, is not of the Father,

but is of the world. 17 And the world passeth away and the lust thereof, but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever.

Father, I pray that my children and GC would never have any desire or love for the things of this world, but that they would always seek You and Your will first. I ask You Father, to protect them from all defilement by the world. I ask that You would keep each one of them pure and holy for Yourself.

Rom 12:2 And be not conformed to this world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. *God, I pray that You would never allow my children or GC to be conformed to this world or to contemporary Christendom in any way. I pray that You would transform them by the renewing of their minds, and that they may test and approve that which is Your good and acceptable and perfect will.*

Wednesday and Saturday

Father, I ask You to lead every single one of my descendants to salvation, all the way to the coming of the Lord, that there would never be even one who does not know You as Savior and Lord and does not fear and reverence You.

Eph 4:1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. *Father, I pray that You would enable each of our C and GC to live their lives in a way that is well-pleasing to You, and worthy of Your high calling for them.*

Gen 2:18 The LORD God said, "It is **not good** for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him." *Lord, if it is not good for them to be alone, I pray that in Your perfect time,*

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that You would bring into each of my children and GC lives the perfect mate You have designed and prescribed for them.

2 Cor 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you. *Father, I pray that my children and GC would always be separate from the world, and that You would keep them from every unclean thing.*

Rom 6:10 The death He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life He lives, He lives to God. 11 In the same way, reckon yourselves dead indeed unto sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. *Lord, I ask that You would teach and prompt each one of them to daily reckon themselves dead unto sin and alive unto You. I ask You to make it real in their experience daily. I ask that You would reveal to each one the wicked Haman living in the palace.*
