

Lord's Day

Psa 127:3 Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. *My grandchildren are the heritage of the Lord. Lord, I thank You for each one of them.*

Rom 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. *Father, I pray that You would draw each and every one of them to Yourself at a very young age.*

Prov 8:17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me. *I pray that they would seek You very early and that You would save each one of them at the earliest age.*

Psa 121:7 The LORD will keep you from all harm — He will watch over your life; 8 the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore. *I pray that You would keep them from all harm, that You would watch over their lives, and their coming and going both now and forevermore.*

Monday

1 Sam 3:21 The LORD continued to appear at Shiloh, and there **He revealed himself to Samuel through his Word.** *I pray that as You revealed Yourself to Samuel through Your Word, that You would reveal Yourself to my grandchildren in Your Word.*

Pro 3:5 **Trust in the LORD with all thine heart;** and lean not unto thine own understanding. 6 In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths. *I pray that You would cause each one of them to trust in You with all their hearts, and that they would not ever rely on their own understanding. Instead, I pray that they would acknowledge You in all their ways, and that You would always direct their paths.*

Lu 2:52 And Jesus **grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and with men.**

1 Sam 2:26 And the boy Samuel continued to grow in stature and in favor with the LORD and with men. *Lord, I pray that just as the boy*

My Grandchildren

Jesus and the boy Samuel grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with You and men, that You would make it true in their lives.

Acts 13:22 I have found David son of Jesse **a man after my own heart**; he will do everything I want him to do. *I pray that You would also find each one to be a man/woman after Your own heart.*

Dan 1:8 But Daniel **purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself** with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank. *Lord, I pray that You would also mold each one to be a man/woman of conviction who will not defile themselves with the world's fare.*

Tuesday

Gen 39:12 She caught him by his cloak and said, "Come to bed with me!" But **he left his cloak in her hand and ran out of the house.** *I pray that You would cause each one of them to be a man/woman of integrity who will flee from all evil things.* It is far better for a man to lose his cloak than to lose his integrity.

2 Tim 3:14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, **15 and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures**, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. *I pray that it will also be said of each one of my grandchildren that how from infancy he/she has known and loved the Scriptures, and from those Scriptures that You would make them wise unto salvation.*

Psa 119:97 Oh, how **I love your law!** I meditate on it all day long. *Father, I pray that they would always love Your Word and meditate on it continually.*

Deut 6:5 **Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.** *Lord, I pray that You would put the love of God in their hearts and they would always love You with all their heart, soul, and strength.*

Wednesday

2 Ki 23:25 Neither before nor after Josiah was there a king like him **who turned to the LORD as he did — with all his heart and with all his soul and with all his strength**, in accordance with all the Law of Moses. *Father, I pray that You would do for my grandchildren what You did for Josiah, and that it will be said of him: “there was never a man like him who turned to You with all their heart, soul, and strength”.*

Ps 139:17 How **precious to me are your thoughts**, O God! How vast is the sum of them! *Father, I pray that Your thoughts would always be very precious to each of my grandchildren.*

Dan 3:18 But even if he does not, we want you to know, O king, that **we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold** you have set up." *Father, I pray for my grandchildren that You would cause each of them to be man/women of integrity like Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who would not bow and worship any false god.*

Ex 23:2 Do not follow the crowd in doing wrong. *Lord, I pray that You would give my grandchildren the courage to stand alone, whatever the cost, and that they would never follow the crowd in doing wrong.*

Thursday

Gen 6:22 **Noah did everything** just as God commanded him.

Ex 40:16 **Moses did everything** just as the LORD commanded him. *Father, I pray for my grandchildren that You would mold them to be like Moses and Noah who did everything the Lord told them to do.*

Num 14:24 But because my servant Caleb has **a different spirit and follows me wholeheartedly**, I will bring him into the land he went to, and his descendants will inherit it. *Father, I pray that You would give my grandchildren a “different spirit” like that of Caleb, and that they will always abide in You wholeheartedly.*

My Grandchildren

2 Chron 26:5 As long as Uzziah **sought the LORD**, God gave him success. *I pray that my grandchildren would always seek You and Your will for their lives and that You would grant them great success. (True success is the accumulation of much Christ-like character.) I pray that they would know Christ (personally and intimately), that they would make Him known, that they would be like Him here, and that they would be with Him there.*

Psa 119:9 Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed thereto according to thy word. 10 I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. 11 **Thy word have I hid in mine heart**, that I might not sin against thee. *Father, I pray that my grandchildren would always seek You, that they would never stray from You, and that they would be faithful to hide Your Word in their hearts.*

Friday

Ps 119:97 Oh, how **I love your law!** I meditate on it all day long. *I pray that my grandchildren would always love Your Word and meditate upon it day and night.*

Psa 119:16 I **delight in your decrees**; I will not neglect your word. *I pray that each of my grandchildren would always find great delight in Your Word and would never neglect it.*

2 Ki 18:5 He (Zedekiah) **trusted in the LORD**, the God of Israel. **There was no one like him** among all the kings of Judah, either before him or after him. *Father, I pray that it will be said of them that “there was no one like him” who trusted in the Lord as he did.*

1 Ki 15:5 For David had **done what was right in the eyes** of the LORD and **had not failed to keep any of the LORD’s commands** all the days of his life — except in the case of Uriah the Hittite. *I pray that they would always do what is right in Your eyes and never fail to keep Your revealed will for them.*

Saturday

Jer 29:13 You will **seek me** and find me when you seek me with all your heart. *Lord, I pray that my grandchildren would always seek You with all their hearts. I thank You for the assurance that those who seek You will indeed find You.*

1 Sam 3:19 The **LORD was with Samuel as he grew up, and he let none of his words fall to the ground.** *I pray that as You were with Samuel as he grew up, that You would be in them as they grow up and that they would never let any of Your words fall to the ground.*

Num 25:11 “Phinehas the priest has turned my anger away from the Israelites; for he was as zealous for my honor as I am.” *Father, I pray that they, like Phinehas, would be as zealous for Your honor as Phinehas was and You Yourself are.*

3 John 1:2 Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. *Lord, good health is such a blessed gift from You. I pray that you would enable my grandchildren to enjoy good health and may You grant them souls that are getting along as well. Thank You!*

Dan 6:4 At this, the administrators and the satraps tried to find grounds for charges against Daniel in his conduct of government affairs, but they were unable to do so. They could find no corruption in him, because he was trustworthy and neither corrupt nor negligent. *Lord, I pray that as people examine my grandchildren’s lives, in an attempt to find grounds for charges against their conduct, or to find any corruption in them, that they could not, because my grands are neither corrupt nor negligent.*

Note: Psalm 138:2 I will bow down toward your holy temple and will praise your name for your love and your faithfulness, for **you have exalted above all things your name and your word.**

I am convinced that there are two things that the Lord delights to hear repeated back to Him in prayer: His Name and His Word. What you will find here are pages out of my own prayer notebook. These are excerpts from my section on praying for **my grandchildren.**

I don't like to repeat memorized prayers, I believe the Lord likes them to be fresh. I have printed example prayers in blue, just to illustrate how to turn God's Word into prayer unto Him.

Remember, this is **my** prayer list. Feel free to use what you like and discard what you don't like or disagree with. My wish in sharing this with you is to encourage you to develop a prayer notebook of your own, and to develop the practice of repeating God's Word back to Him in prayer.

Prayer does not fit us for the greater ministry, prayer is the greater ministry. Oswald Chambers
