Daily

Col 4:12 Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He **is always wrestling in prayer for you**, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured. *Lord, may You enable and empower me to be a faithful prayer wrestler and keep all the believers in prayer before You. I pray that You would cause every believer to stand firm in the faith and in all Your will, mature and fully assured.*

1 Thess 5:25 Brothers, pray for us. *I pray for the local and universal body of Christ, all the believers everywhere. I thank You that You love them, You gave Yourself up for them, and now abide in them. May You make Your abiding presence real to each and every one of them today.*

Lord's Day

Eph 4:1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. This is the calling that every believer has received: "It is God's will that you should be holy." 1 Thess 4:3 Lord, *I pray that You would prompt and enable every believer to live a life worthy of the calling to which You have called them, a holy and separated life.*

Rom 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God. *Father, I pray that every believer would present their bodies to You, a living sacrifice, holy, and acceptable unto You. May they not be*

conformed to this world, but may You transform them by the renewing of their minds, that they may prove that Your will is good, acceptable, and perfect.

2 Cor 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. 17 For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. 18 So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. *Lord, I pray that the believers would not lose heart. Though they are wasting away outwardly, may You renew them inwardly day by day. May You use their light and momentary troubles to achieve for them an eternal glory that outweighs them all. May You prompt them to fix their eyes on eternal things rather the material things which are seen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.*

Phil 1:9 And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, 10 so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, 11 filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ — to the glory and praise of God. *Father, this is my prayer for the believers: may their love abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that they may be able to discern what is best, and may they be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ. May their lives bring glory and praise to You.*

Ex 34:24 I will drive out nations before you and enlarge your territory, and no one will covet your land when you go up three times each year to appear before the LORD your God. *Lord, I ask that You would protect the believer's homes as they*

“go up” each Lord’s day to meet with the believers, and that no one would covet the things You have blessed them with in their absence.

Monday

Eph 4:21 Surely you heard of Him and were taught in Him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. 22 You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self (by reckoning self dead to sin), which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; 23 to be made new in the attitude of your minds; 24 and to put on the New Self (by reckoning self alive unto God), created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness. *Lord, I pray that every believer would put into practice what they were taught in Your Word, to put off the old self (Adam) by reckoning themselves dead to sin, to be made new in the attitude of their minds, and to put on the New Self (Christ) by reckoning themselves alive unto You.*

Rom 13:14 But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh. (By reckoning self dead to sin and alive unto God). *Lord, I pray that the saints would daily put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh.*

Gal 5:16 So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the cravings of the sinful nature. *I pray that You would enable the believers to always live by Your Spirit and not gratify the cravings of the sinful nature.*

Rom 6:10 The death He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life He lives, He lives to God. 11 In the same way, **reckon yourselves dead indeed unto sin and alive to God** in Christ Jesus. *Father, I pray that just as Christ died to sin once for all, and the life He lives He lives to You, may the believers reckon themselves dead unto sin and alive unto You.*

1 Pet 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light. *Father, I thank You that the saints are indeed a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people who belong to You. May they declare Your praises Who called them out of darkness and into Your wonderful light.*

Tuesday

Col 2:6 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord (by grace, through faith), so walk ye in Him (by grace, through faith). 7 Having been firmly rooted in Him, and now being built up in Him, and established in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. *Father, I thank You that the believers are firmly and eternally **rooted** in Christ and are now being **established** in the faith, may they abound therein with thanksgiving. As they received Christ (by grace through faith), may they learn to walk in the very same way. May You teach them how to live by grace and reveal to each one the futility of attempting to live by Israel's now set-aside Law.*

Phil 1:21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. *Lord, I pray that every believer would be firmly convinced that to be absent from the body is to be with Christ and to be with Him there is infinitely better than being here. While they are here, may Christ indeed be their life.*

Col 3:1 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. 3 For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ, Who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. *Lord, I pray that every believer*

would understand their position “in Christ” and already raised with Him and seated with Him. When Christ died, they died with Him and are now hidden with Christ in God. May they set their hearts and minds on things above, not on earthly things. May they know for certain that when Christ appears, they will appear with Him in glory.

2 Tim 1:9 God has saved us and called us to a holy life — not because of anything we have done but because of His own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time. *How then shall we live? May every believer know for certain that You have called us to a **holy life**. However the best we can offer is “filthy rags”. They cannot live a holy life by self effort. If it is to be done, then God in His grace must do it. May they invite Your indwelling Spirit to live His holy life in and through them.*

Jn 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have **peace**. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of **good cheer**; I have overcome the world. *Father, I thank You for the things you have spoken so that the believers may have Your peace. Though they may have tribulation in the world, may You enable them to be of good cheer, because You have overcome the world.*

Eph 4:11 It was He who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, 12 to prepare God’s people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up. *Father, I pray for those who are responsible for the shepherding and building up the local assemblies. I pray that You would protect them from the evil one and that You would grant them much wisdom as they shepherd the flock and deal with all the problems they must*

face. I pray that their work would be a real joy to them and not a burden.

Wednesday

Jn 17:11 I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, **protect them by the power of Your Name**— the Name you gave Me— so that they may be one as We are One. *Father, I thank You, that by this prayer of the Lord Jesus Christ, that every believer is **protected forever** by the power and the Name of El Gibbor (the infinitely powerful **protector**).*

2 Ki 6:15 When the servant of the man of God got up and went out early the next morning, an army with horses and chariots had surrounded the city. "Oh, my lord, what shall we do?" the servant asked. 16 "**Don't be afraid,**" the prophet answered. "Those who are with us are more than those who are with them." 17 And Elisha prayed, "**O LORD, open his eyes so he may see.**" Then the LORD opened the servant's eyes, and he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. *Lord, I pray that when the believers are distressed and afraid, may You be pleased to open their eyes that they may see the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around them. Let them know that the One Who indwells them is infinitely more than those against them.*

Jn 17:13 "I am coming to You now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so **that they may have the full measure of My joy within them**".

Jn 17:17 **Sanctify them** (conditionally) through Thy truth: Thy Word is truth. *Father, I thank You that every believer is **positionally sanctified** by You, currently and eternally so, but perhaps they may not be living a sanctified life. I pray that*

they would yield to You and allow You the freedom to do Your sanctifying work in their daily walk.

Phil 3:8 What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish that I may gain Christ. *Lord, I pray that every believer would consider everything else a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus the Lord.*

Thursday

2 Pet 3:18 **But grow in the grace** and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever! Amen. (Those believers who fail to understand and appropriate grace will fail to live a godly life in Christ Jesus.) *Lord, I acknowledge that You are the One Who is the ultimate Source of spiritual growth. I pray that You would give every believer a hunger and thirst for a deeper and more intimate relationship with You. May You enable each one to grow in the grace (in the understanding, appreciation, application, appropriation, apprehension and affection) and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.*

Heb 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the heavenly calling, **fix your thoughts on Jesus**, the Apostle and High Priest Whom we confess. *Lord, I pray that You would daily prompt the believers to fix their thoughts upon Jesus, Who is the Apostle and High Priest Whom we confess.*

Heb 12:2 **Let us fix our eyes on Jesus**, the Author and Perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Father, *I pray that You would prompt the saints to fix their eyes upon Jesus, the Author and Perfecter of*

faith, Who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at Your right hand.

Col 1:28 So, naturally, we proclaim Christ! We warn everyone we meet, and we teach everyone we can, all that we know about him, so that we may **bring every man up to his full maturity in Christ.** *Lord, I thank You that You are in the process of bringing every man up to his full maturity in Christ. I pray that You would put it into their hearts to naturally proclaim Christ. May You prompt each one to warn everyone they meet and teach everyone they can all that they know about You.*

1 Pet 2:12 Live **such good lives** among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day He visits us. *Lord, I pray that every believer would be a living, glorious display to the world of the abundant life in Christ. I pray that they would **know** it, that they would **experience** it, and that they would be a **glorious display** of it. May their godly lifestyle draw many to glorify Christ on the day He visits us.*

Friday

Heb 13:13 Let us, then, go forth unto **Him** outside the camp, bearing the reproach He bore. *Lord, I pray that You would draw every believer outside the camp, outside the camp of liberalism, outside the camp of contemporary Christendom, outside every camp that is not under the Lordship of Christ, and go forth onto **Him**, bearing the reproach He bore.*

Phil 1:6 Be confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. *Lord, I thank You that You are the One Who began the good work in each of us and You are the very same One Who*

*will carry that work on to completion. We are **Your** workmanship, may each one yield to the work that **You are doing in us and wish to do in us and through us.***

2 Cor 1:21 Now it is God who makes both us and you **stand firm in Christ**. He anointed us, set His seal of ownership on us, and put His Spirit in our hearts, 22 as a deposit guaranteeing what is to come. Isa 7:9b If you do not stand firm in your faith, you will not stand at all. *Lord, I thank **You** that **You are the One who makes the believers stand firm in Christ. We have no ability to make ourselves stand firm. You anointed us, You set Your seal of ownership on us, and You put Your Spirit in our hearts as a deposit guaranteeing what is to come. Thank You. May every believer rest in this blessed truth.***

Col 3:15 **Let the peace of Christ rule** in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. *Lord, the peace of Christ isn't something we can concoct, instead You have said: "**let it rule in your hearts.**" I pray that the believers would **let** Your peace rule in their hearts, and may they be thankful.*

Phile 1:6 I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ. *Father, I pray that every believer would be active in sharing their faith in Christ and as a result, may they have a full understanding of every good thing that is theirs as a result of being in Christ.*

Saturday

1 Thess 4:3 **It is God's will that you should be holy**: that you should **avoid sexual immorality**; 4 that each of you should learn to **control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable**, 5 not in passionate lust like the heathen, who do not know God. *Lord, I pray that **Your Spirit would mature every***

believer into living a holy life, that they would avoid sexual immortality, that each one would learn to control their own body in a way that is holy and honorable, and not in passionate lust like the heathen who do not know You.

Gal 5:16 So I say, **live by the Spirit**, and you will not gratify the cravings of the sinful nature. *Lord, thank You for indwelling every believer by the Person of Your Spirit. If we would allow Him to live His life in us, we would not gratify the cravings of our sinful nature. It is my prayer that every believer would indeed live by Your Spirit.*

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. 12 It (grace) teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, 13 while we wait for the blessed hope — the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ. *Lord, I thank You for Your grace that brings salvation, and all that Your grace does in the believer's lives. **Grace teaches** the believers to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age. May every believer invite Your Spirit to do this work of grace in their life.*

"The daily walk of the Christian is to be carried out on the basis of pure grace. Those who fail to understand and appropriate grace will fail to live a godly life in Christ Jesus". Author? *Lord, I pray that Your Spirit would teach and prompt every believer to understand and appropriate grace in their daily walk.*

2 Thess 3:3 But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one. *Lord, I ask You to protect them as they gather together on the Lord's day tomorrow. Please protect them from invasion as they meet together. Please*

grant them safety on the road as they travel and protect their homes while they are away.

Heb 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: 25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. *Lord, may each one of us consider our brothers and sisters to provoke them to love and good works, and to be faithful in assembling themselves together with their local congregation.*

Col 1:6 All over the world this gospel is bearing fruit and growing, just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and understood God's grace in all its truth. 9 For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. 10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please Him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God. *Father, I pray for every believer, I thank You for each and every one of them, and I ask You to fill them with knowledge of Your will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. I pray that they may live a life worthy of You and please You in every way. May You, the True Vine, bear fruit in every one and grow them up in their knowledge of God.*
